

BP 1310 REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE BOARD

Government Code Sections 54952.2, 54953 et seq., and 54961

Regular meetings of the Board shall be held semi-monthly and normally on Tuesdays. Regular meetings of the Board shall normally be held at 3801 Market Street, Riverside, CA 92501.

A notice identifying the location, date, and time of each regular meeting of the Board shall be posted at each community college in the District at least ten days prior to the meeting and shall remain posted to and including the time of the meeting.

Agendas for each regular meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be posted 72 hours prior to the meeting and shall remain posted until the day and time of the meeting. All regular meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be held within the boundaries of the District except in cases where the Board is meeting with another local agency or is meeting with its attorney to discuss pending litigation if the attorney's office is outside the District.

All regular and special meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be open to the public, be accessible to persons with disabilities, and otherwise comply with Brown Act provisions, except as required or permitted by law.

AP 1310 REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE BOARD

Regular meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be held normally on the first and third Tuesdays of each month commencing at 6:00 p.m. at a location within the geographical boundaries of the District. The meeting on the first Tuesday will contain Board Committee items for discussion, as well as any other items as deemed necessary.

Agendas for each meeting will be posted at least 72 hours prior to the meeting at each campus/college within the District and shall remain so posted up to and including the time of such meeting. If, by reason of fire, flood, earthquake or other emergency, it shall be unsafe to meet at the posted location, meetings shall be held for the duration of the emergency at the place designated by the Chancellor, or designee, in a notice to the local media that have requested notice, by the most rapid means of communication available at the time.
